The Hall's Management Committee met in March and there are a few things on which I would like to report.

Greendays has started work on our boundary fence and the levelling of the land next to the Village Hall. It is looking very good and we hope that it will be finished by the time you read this.

The tai chi classes continue to grow with new members joining each month. If you would like to join, just come to one of the three classes on Monday afternoons and fill up a form. The first session is free with subsequent sessions costing £2 when you attend. As I reported some months ago, we may have to increase this when the funding from East Herts runs out. I have not heard from anyone who thinks that raising the fee to £3 will cause them problems.

We noticed at one tai chi class that the central heating was making funny noises. We called an engineer who called in the boiler company as the boiler is still under guarantee. It was fixed by the next Monday.

We had thought about having another fitness class (not tai chi) on a Wednesday afternoon. The problem is finding someone to be "in charge". The tai chi classes are looked after by committee members who can cover for each other when needed. If you would be interested in looking after say a dance class, could you let me know and we will see what can be arranged.

We discussed the request from the Parish Council to put a defibrillator outside the Hall. We had concerns about the cost implications (which were not clear) and the possibility of vandalism. We did not rule it out and felt that we should pursue this further.
